**Bureau of Motor Vehicles to temporarily close from March 23 to April 6, 2020**

U.S. VIRGIN ISLANDS— Director Barbara Jackson-McIntosh would like to inform the motoring public that as per Governor Albert Bryan Jr. press conference on March 19, 2020, the Bureau of Motor Vehicles will be temporarily closed from March 23, to April 6, 2020.

As Governor Bryan announced, driver's licenses and vehicle registrations will be extended for 60 days during this state of emergency. However, the community can take advantage of the bureau's online vehicle registration process. During this period, the bureau will waive the requirement for inspection for any customer that renew their vehicle registration online.
