**Bureau of Motor Vehicles to remain Closed until May 4, 2020**

U.S. VIRGIN ISLANDS— Director Barbara Jackson-McIntosh would like to inform the motoring public that due to the extension of the State of Emergency and the stay-at-home order by Governor Albert Bryan Jr, the Bureau of Motor Vehicles will remain closed until May 4, 2020.

As Governor Bryan announced, driver's licenses and vehicle registrations will be extended for 60 days during this State of Emergency. However, the community can take advantage of the bureau's online vehicle registration process. During this period, the bureau will waive the requirement for inspection for any customer that renew their vehicle registration online.
